On 19th August 2025, a Poster making and Slogan Writing Competition was organized by the Department of Student Welfare, RBBSU, in collaboration with the Faculty of Science, Faculty of Arts, Faculty of Commerce and Management, School of Hotel Management, Faculty of Fine Arts and Fashion Design.

The event aimed to spread awareness about the ill effects of ragging and encourage students to use their creativity to promote a ragging-free campus.

Call for Entries

The call for entries was announced on **07-08-2025** through the college notice boards, departmental emails, official WhatsApp groups, and classroom announcements. Students from all courses and years were invited to participate. The last date for registration was **08-08-2025**, which was later extended to 18-08-2025, as students were kept showing interest in participation.

Criteria and Guidelines for Participation

- 1. All participants must bring their own material and sheet for the competition.
- 2. The sheet size for both competitions is A2 (half the size of the newspaper)
- 3. All participating students will be given two hours for their respective competition.
- 4. In the slogan writing Competition, the slogan must be original and self-composed.
- 5. Departments/ faculties/ schools were requested to nominate a minimum of 5 students for the slogan writing and 5 students for the poster making competition.

Guidelines of Poster Making

- 1. The competition is open to all the students of RBB Subharti University.
- 2. The poster should revolve around the theme given.
- 3. Any medium can be used (sketch, crayons, watercolours, oil pastels) etc.
- 4. Include your names, departments, class.
- 5. In case any participant is found violating the rules shall be disqualified immediately.
- 6. The poster should be original and not copied from other resources.
- 7. The poster should clearly convey the intended message or theme.
- 8. Clarity and conscience of language are important.
- 9. The decision of the judges is usually final.
- 10. The poster should be neat, balanced and well organized.

Guidelines of Slogan Making

- 1. The slogan should be an original creation.
- 2. The word limit for slogan writing is 20-30 words.
- 3. The slogan should be easy to remember and repeat.
- 4. Avoid complex language while writing the slogan.
- 5. The slogan should be relevant to the themes, mission, and inspiration.
- 6. The slogan should be written in such a way that it inspires, makes people feel motivated.
- 7. The slogan should promote positive values.
- 8. The slogan should be clear and easy to understand.
- 9. The slogan should be neat and readable.
- 10. Make sure the slogan clearly reflects the main idea or theme.




