All Holidays (National, Institutional & Restricted) for the calendar year 2026 for the University shall be as under:-

NATIONAL HOLIDAYS:

1	Republic Day	Monday	26 th January
2	Independence Day	Saturday	15 th August
3	First Independence Day of United India	Wednesday	21 st October

- All students, teachers and staff will report for celebration (barring those who are on emergency duty) and will disperse after celebration (Only for Republic & Independence Day).
- 15th August will be celebrated as “Transfer of Power and Prayer Day”. On this day, after flag hoisting and singing of National Anthem, two minutes silence will be kept to pay homage to those who sacrificed their lives due to division of the Country. Prayers will be made for re-unification of India. No sweets will be distributed and no cultural program will be held.
- 21st October will be celebrated as first Independence Day of United India with ‘enthusiasm and fervor’.

Unit Heads will disseminate the following information to all concerned:

- Two attendances, in place of one, will be given in all subjects on attending the programme by students.
- Two days’ absence will be marked in each subject if not attended the programme by students.
- Teaching and Non-Teaching staff who do not attend above programmes will be marked Absent/Leave Without Pay which will not be adjusted anywhere.

Additional/Restricted Holidays:


Any two holidays (not en-cashable) may be availed with prior information and permission of the head of the unit/institution on the following occasions:
